LANDLORD/HOMEOWNER CONSENT FORM

The Save On Energy CoolSaver Program provides free services and various rebates to eligible residents in Ottawa and the Greater Toronto Area to improve the energy efficiency of their home cooling systems with the goal of reducing energy consumption on the grid in these areas.

For participants that are tenants, it is required to have the consent of the landlord or the homeowner to perform services at their property.
